MEDITATION

Westminster Confession of Faith XXXIII

II. The end of God's appointing this day is for the manifestation of the glory of his mercy, in the eternal salvation of the elect; and of his justice, in the damnation of the reprobate, who are wicked and disobedient. For then shall the righteous go into everlasting life, and receive that fullness of joy and refreshing, which shall come from the presence of the lord; but the wicked who know not God, and obey not the gospel of Jesus Christ, shall be cast into eternal torments, and be punished with everlasting destruction from the presence of the Lord, and from the glory of his power.

The God that holds you over the pit of hell, much as one holds a spider, or some loathsome insect, over the fire, abhors you, and is dreadfully provoked. His wrath toward you burns like a fire, he looks upon you as worthy of nothing else but to be cast into the fire.

He is of purer eyes than to bear to have you in his sight...you have offended him infinitely more than ever a stubborn rebel did his prince, and yet, it is nothing but his hand that holds you from falling into the fire every moment.

It is to be ascribed to nothing else that you did not go hell last night, that you were suffered to awake again in this world, after you closed your eyes to sleep. O sinner, consider the fearful danger you are in, it is a great furnace of wrath, a wide and bottomless pit, full of the fire of wrath, that you are held over in the hand of that God.
